The List Gallery is a little gem of an art gallery located in the Lang Performing Arts Center on the Swarthmore College campus. Andrea Packer has

been the gallery's only director since it opened in 1995. The gallery has four exhibits per year. They include works by the Swarthmore students but also works by outside artists such as the current show on the Quilts of Gee's Bend, Alabama. Andrea said poor blacks in Gee's Bend have been making extraordinary quilts since the 1930's. During the Depression, they made the quilts to keep warm but eventually they sold the quilts to make money. *(continued on reverse)*
