World Polio Day in Swarthmore

October 25, 2018 Program: Barbara Amstutz

Barbara's talk discussed 4 areas of her life: career, family and grandchildren, two of her favorite places and the League of Women Voters.



Barbara's career spanned experiences

in law and marketing for pharmaceutical, food, weight loss and orthopedic businesses. This was followed by a photo display of her family and grandchildren. We then traveled to two of Barbara's favorite places, Acadia National Park and the Grand Teton's in Jackson Hole, Wyoming. The iconic scenery of these special places, the unique wildlife of the area and natural landscape during the different seasons were featured by her photography from many trips to Maine and Wyoming.

The last part of the presentation addressed Barbara's role as President of the local chapter for the League of Women Voters. The Central Delaware County Chapter has 150 members and is one of the largest chapters in Pennsylvania. The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan civic organization with one national organization in Washington, D.C., 50 state organizations and 1000 local chapters. The mission of the League is to encourage knowledgeable and active participation in government, to increase engagement in the community and to influence public policy through education and advocacy. The League is known for their candidate forums, voter registration drives and participation at naturalization ceremonies.

The League will be hosting a talk on the midterm elections by Terry Madonna, a political science professor from Franklin and Marshall College, and well known polling expert often heard on National Public Radio.
