## Last Meeting Summary

Linton Stables and Rosemary Fox told us an example of applying the old motivational slogan, "If given a lemon, make lemonade". After being given notice from Swarthmore College that the Swarthmore Community Center (SCC) would have to vacate the building it is currently using, the SCC developed plans for a much better and bigger facility. The new facility will allow SCC to host a much wider range of activities, including plays, dances, and concerts. Linton is President and Rosemary is Vice-President of the SCC Board. Starting two years ago, the SCC, along with Swarthmore Senior Citizens Association and Swarthmore Town Center, initiated a search for a new space. Fortunately, the Swarthmore Methodist Church was considering making some of its' space available for other users. The result of all this effort is the Park Avenue Community Center (PACC), which will be starting this January 1. Rosemary will be the Executive Director of PACC.

The outstanding feature of the new Center will be the current sanctuary. The Church is removing the existing pews, to be replaced with portable, and more comfortable, seating. This room can be used for large gatherings such as concerts and plays. There are several other rooms available for use for meetings, fitness, teen hang-outs, and child care. The kitchen will be renovated to become a commercial certified kitchen. As a commercial certified kitchen, it can be rented for use by groups wanting to host dinner events. The PACC has an initial renovation budget of one million dollars, a lot of which has already been donated by the Centennial Foundation. There will be much more 16th
