both the eggs and sperm are negatively impacted by hotter water. Their chances of hooking up appear to be decreasing.

Another negative impact of climate change on the ocean life is acidification. For various reasons, the ocean water is becoming more acidic. Karen has conducted other experiments to measure the impact of acidification on shelled sea animals such as clams and crabs. Their shell thicknesses are decreasing. Karen showed some photos of clams with large holes in their shells. She said this impact extends to our local waters such as crab fishing in the Delaware and Chesapeake bays.

Karen asked us to speak to our friends and relatives about the harm of climate change. According to national polls, only a few persons ever talk about climate change. She recommended the website <u>www.climateinteractive.org</u>, as a place to learn talking points.
