# Last Meeting Summary

Melissa Lyons, the new Director of the Delaware County Health Department (DCHD), faced interesting questions and comments when she spoke to Swarthmore Rotary. Melissa presented an overview of the organization and duties of the new department. As you know, the DCHD was established several years ago and Melissa is the first permanent Director. One Rotarian stated that public health activities were already being done by the communities before the DCHD was formed. Melissa acknowledged this comment. Another Rotarian questioned how the return on additional taxes will be measured. Melissa responded by first stating that she hoped to have most of the Department's costs covered by state and federal government grants. She also stated that the Department will provide information on what it does. It also will track trends in community heath.

The DCHD is divided into three parts. The Division of Environmental Health has 13 health inspectors who conduct inspections of facilities such as restaurants, pools, private sewers and wells. The Division of

This Division was responsible for the Covid response. The Division of Personal Health covers diseases such as TB, HIV, rabies, and sexual diseases.
