Last Week's Speaker Mark Kuperberg

Mark Kuperberg of the college gave us his view of how we got into this economic mess, how bad it is, and how we can get out of it.

He described a "perfect storm" of a housing bubble, bad borrowers, bad lenders, unregulated securitization, excessive leverage, negligent rating agencies, and financial engineering as the "how we got here". The "how bad" is the worst decline in unemployment in 100 years, even faster than the Great Depression, and a whirlwind of leverage destruction, corporate profitability declines, and government interventions that has gone from a panicky unraveling to a challenging environment. His "how do we get out" involves historic government involvement and reregulation.
