#### Rain Garden Workshop Sept. 16

The Chester-Ridley-Crum Watershed Association is partnering with the Environmental Advisory Councils including Swarthmore Borough and Nether Providence, to promote the use of rain gardens by homeowners to collectively manage storm water and protect our streams and water supplies. Rain gardens are planted areas designed to soak up rain water, which drains from a roof or other impervious surface.

Collectively, individual homeowners can protect drinking water supplies and local streams and enhance biodiversity by installing rain gardens on their properties.

The speaker will be local rain garden designer, **Catherine Renzi**. Come early (between 6:30 and 6:45 pm) to view newly installed rain garden at nearby Thatcher Park.
