Following is the note sent by the Tokyo Rotary Club:

First of all, we express deeply thanks for you.

For this disaster, we have received your large amount of contribution US\$21,500.

About the urgent support, we sent a contribution from Tokyo RC to the governor society.

In addition, we set up a temporary reconstruction aid project committee in Tokyo RC and discuss it on a long-term premise supporting now. The directionality of the support that we think about, we are going to support upbringing of the talented youth people of the disaster area.
