Dear Club President,

The District 7450 Rotaplast Team has just returned from its highly successful mission to Retalhuleu,

Guatemala. I am writing to thank you for making this possible. One hundred and six children received plastic surgery to correct the deformities of cleft lip and palate. This was a truly life changing event for these children, and has given them a normal life that they would not have enjoyed otherwise. Before receiving this procedure, children are hidden away, shunned and stigmatized through no fault of their own. Today, one hundred and six children in Guatemala no longer face that life.

The Rotaplast team consisted of twenty nine people. Nineteen were plastic surgeons, anaesthesiologists, nurses, a pediatrician, a dentist and a speech therapist. They came from across the country and as far as The Czech Republic. There were also ten Rotarians from District 7450 who supported the operational aspects of this enterprise. All were volunteers who took time away from their busy lives, and traveled at their own expense in the true spirit of Rotary.
