Rebecca Bonner described her journey to founding the Bridge Way School, the area's 1st recovery high school, which serves students who have been treated for addiction. Different from a treatment program, Bridge Way is an accredited academic high school.The school is

located on the 2nd floor of a synagogue in Manayunk and currently serves 7 students, 4 of whom will graduate in June. Typically 8 of 10 students who return to their prior school instead of a recovery school relapse in their first year, while research shows that those who attend a recovery school for at least 3 months are able to maintain sobriety for an average of 8 times longer than before they attended a sober school. 8 of 10 students at the Bridge Way School stayed sober, so the program seems to be successful.
