# **News Years Resolution Statistics**

(Source: University of Scranton Journal of Clinical Psychology, December 13, 2012)

- Percent of Americans who **usually** make New Year's Resolutions = 45%
- Percent of Americans who **infrequently** make New Year's Resolutions = 17%
- Percent of Americans who absolutely never make New Year's Resolutions = 38%
- Percent of people who are successful in achieving their Resolution = 8%
- Percent who have infrequent success = 49%
- Percent who never succeed and fail on their resolution each year = 24%

People who explicitly make resolutions are 10 times more likely to attain their goals than people who don't explicitly make resolutions

Type of Resolutions (above 100% because of multiple resolutions)

- Self Improvement or education related resolutions, 47%
- Weight related resolutions38% Money related resolutions, 34%
- Relationship related resolutions, 31%

### **Age Success Rates**

- Percent of people in their twenties who achieve their resolution each year = 39%
- Percent of people over 50 who achieve their resolution each year = 14%

### Length of Resolutions

- Resolution maintained through first week = 75%
- Past two weeks = 71%
- Past one month = 64%
- Past six months = 46%
