promote interaction between departments, reduce the carbon footprints, and, of course, reduce the cost? The College plans three new buildings in the near future. These buildings are partly necessitated by an increase in enrollment of 200 over the period of a decade and partly to replace some older buildings. Clearly the college has been one of the most successful growth industries in Delaware County recently.

For those of us who may have wondered why colleges such as Swarthmore don't use their endowment to reduce tuition, it was fortuitous that Anthony Coschignano, a prospective member, was at the meeting. Anthony is Director of Finance and Administration at the College. In a separate conversation, he explained that the College has to keep its tuition comparable to its competition. He also said the current movement to have colleges use their endowments to reduce tuition would not work because the endowments are not large enough to substantially reduce the tuition permanently. All bad news for parents.
