stop moving checks around and just transmit check images. The 2008 crisis resulted in more bank regulations and lower interest rates. Therefore, banks have higher costs and are making less money on their loans. As a result of this, banks increased their fees and have turned their branch staff into a sales force. As more and more money handling is done automatically, Brian predicted that bank branches will have no humans in the future.
