April 7th Project Cure

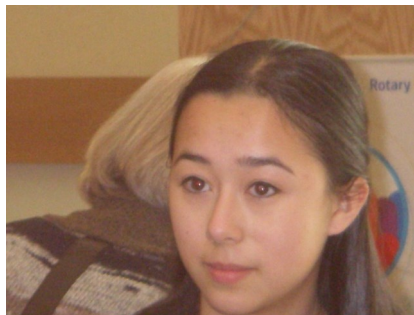
